Chardonnay Golf Club & Vineyards is an 18-hole semi-private golf facility located just outside of Napa in Jameson Canyon, at the gateway to the world renowned Napa Valley wine district. Chardonnay's championship golf course offers a variety of challenges for players of all skill levels. The 18-hole layout features a unique blend of golf holes consisting of six par fives, six par fours and six par threes that meander through over 150 acres of Chardonnay vineyards and feature numerous lakes and creek crossings and a wide variety of native trees, shrubs and wildlife. Unlike virtually all courses today, Chardonnay's golfers are not asked to play amidst any private residences. Several areas of the property are designed as wildlife preserves and are dedicated to maintaining wildlife habitat among the vineyards and fairways. Sharing the property with the golfers are several species of birds including hawks, kites, kestrels, hummingbirds, and an occasional golden eagle. In the early morning or late evening hours rabbits, squirrels, foxes, our bobcat family on #16 and many other "critters" stroll through the fairways.

Eagle Vines Vineyards and Golf Club is the premiere Napa Valley golf course situated in the foothills with vineyard views in every direction. Eagle Vines was founded on the belief that nature and golf were meant to co-exist in magnificent harmony. Eagle Vines has made a profound commitment to protecting the extraordinary natural environment of the beautiful Napa Valley. Eagle Vines Golf Club is the perfect blend of a first-rate facility highlighted by a challenging golf course tucked into the beautiful landscape of the Napa Valley.

Eagle Vines is an 18 hole, par 72 golf course, designed in part by the World Golf Hall of Famer, Johnny Miller. This Napa Golf Club is not only challenging, but an excellent way to indulge all the senses. Eagle Vines is one of the very few golf courses that is not surrounded by homes, it is pure golf in nature.

Tuscan-Born.....Sonoma-Raised

Viansa was born from a family legacy instrumental in establishing California as a world-renowned wine region. When Viansa was founded in 1990 their vision was to create an immersive experience of both the rich culture of Italy and the bounty of Sonoma to share with the world. Northern Italian winemaking tradition from their Sebastiani family's roots in Lucca are combined with the rich natural environment of the Sonoma Valley.

Surrounding the villa, the property cascades into estate vineyards and an adjacent wetland preserve, which provides 97 acres of beautiful natural habitat for migratory birds, waterfowl, and native plants. The stewardship of this land has been a pillar of the Viansa mission throughout its history, and offers beautiful birdsong and seasonal displays of waterfowl migration to guests.

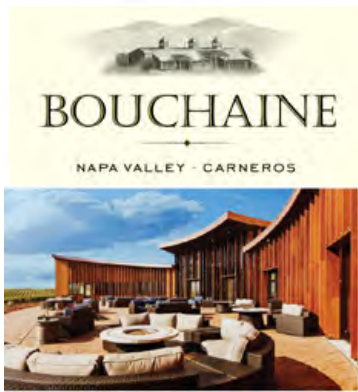
The vineyard has a multitude of soil types, elevations and exposures, allowing Viansa to grow each Estate varietal in specially selected blocks. The flagship wine, Ossidiana, is named for the obsidian that is found in the soils, and pays homage to the obsidian arrowheads left behind by the Miwok tribe that originally inhabited the area.

It is Viansa's warm, engaging and celebratory experience that continues to drive guests and members to Viansa's hilltop villa where guests are treated as amici di famiglia, or "friends of the family." With a panoramic view of the entire Sonoma valley, olive tree-lined vineyards and a 97-acre wetland preserve, Viansa Winery has been a stand-out wine country destination for over 30 years.

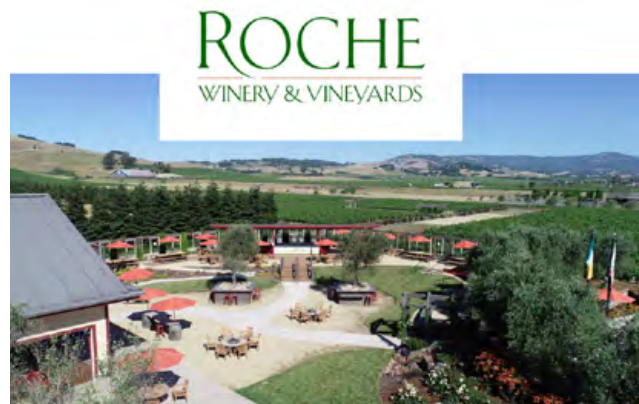

WINERY TOUR LOCATIONS



Originally planted in the 1880's, Bouchaine is the oldest continuously operating winery in Carneros, a region located on the southern tip of Napa Valley. Bouchaine's focus is to craft vibrant, exciting wines with the elegance of Burgundy, the exuberance of California and the terroir of Carneros. They use sustainable farming methods such as cover crops to prevent soil erosion and to add organic matter that sustains the healthy balance of microbes and improves friability and moisture retention. They also encourage beneficial insects to thrive in the vineyard and outcompete other pests. Raptor perches are used to encourage hawks which mitigate gopher damage. Composting, water conservation and deficit irrigation are also used.

Wines from the Rhône Valley and Burgundy were proprietor John Sweazey's favorites during his nine-month adventure around Europe in the early 70s. John learned to appreciate the importance of wine to the European culture, experienced warm and welcoming hospitality, and tasted some life-changing wines. Almost 30 years later, he purchased a 16-acre plot of land in the heart of the Carneros region of Sonoma. The Anaba estate sits in the western part of the Carneros appellation where cool Pacific breezes flow up the gently sloping, sustainably farmed vineyards, slowing down the ripening process and allowing the grapes to develop robust flavors and distinctive varietal characteristics.

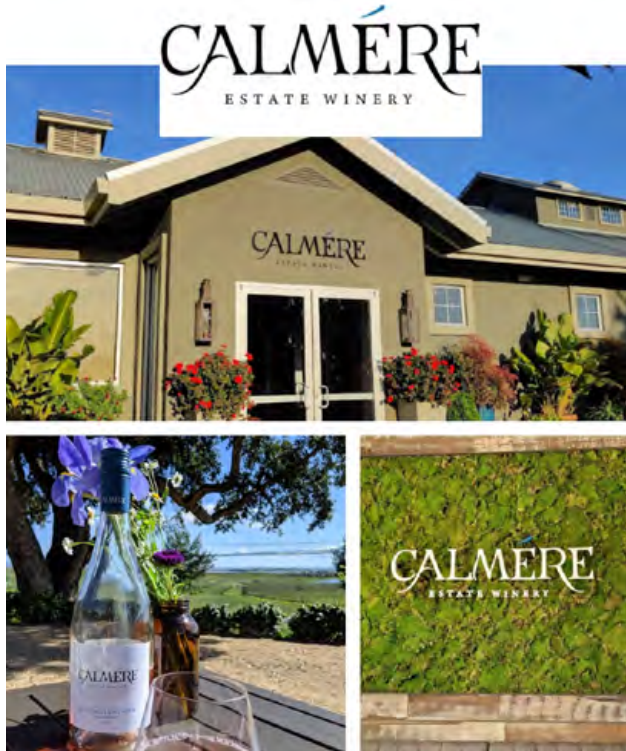

Integrated pest management consists of bird boxes stationed throughout the vineyards, attracting bluebirds and owls which feed on pest populations. Raptor perches are used to encourage hawks which mitigate gopher damage. Composting, water conservation and deficit irrigation are also used.

WINERY TOUR LOCATIONS



More than 35 years after Tony and Herta Peju founded Peju Province Winery in Rutherford, daughters Lisa and Ariana Peju opened Calmère Estate Winery and tasting room. In 2016 the Peju family purchased the 100-acre estate and winery in the Carneros region of Napa Valley. The goal is to produce exceptional Burgundian varietals that are ideally suited to the growing conditions in Carneros.

In 2006, Ariana Peju spearheaded the installation of solar panels at the winery. The panels provide almost 40% of the winery's energy use. PEJU's Rutherford Estate Vineyard was California Certified Organic (CCOF), in 2009 the winery and vineyards were certified as both a Napa County Green Winery and Bay Area Green Business, in 2019 all of their estate vineyards were certified fish friendly. The commitment to sustainability continues on today.

Fred and Nancy Cline built Jacuzzi Family Vineyards in 2005 as an homage to Fred's grandfather, Valeriano Jacuzzi, who invented the namesake spa pump in his youth and later inspired grandson Fred's love of winemaking. The 18,000-square-foot Tuscan-style property was modeled on the Jacuzzi family's ancestral home in Italy, and features a traditional piazza in its center where guests can taste wine and picnic.

Jacuzzi is committed to farming sustainably and has developed some innovative practices to achieve their goals. The Green String farming method is a system the vineyard uses to promote and enhance biodiversity in the soil and biological cycles. Over 1,500 sheep and 500 goats are brought to the vineyard at various times of the year. The animals eat weeds and plant matter left over after harvest.

Crushed volcanic cinder provides the vineyard soils with all the possible nutrients known to nature. The vine as all other organisms has a complete immunological system, if it's nutrition is in balance it will not be sick, and it will not get bugs. They rely on nature to control pests with no use of harmful pesticides. Jacuzzi Family Vineyards is also solar, which supplies 100% of its electricity needs. This has improved air quality by reducing 690,000 lbs. of noxious greenhouse gases per year.

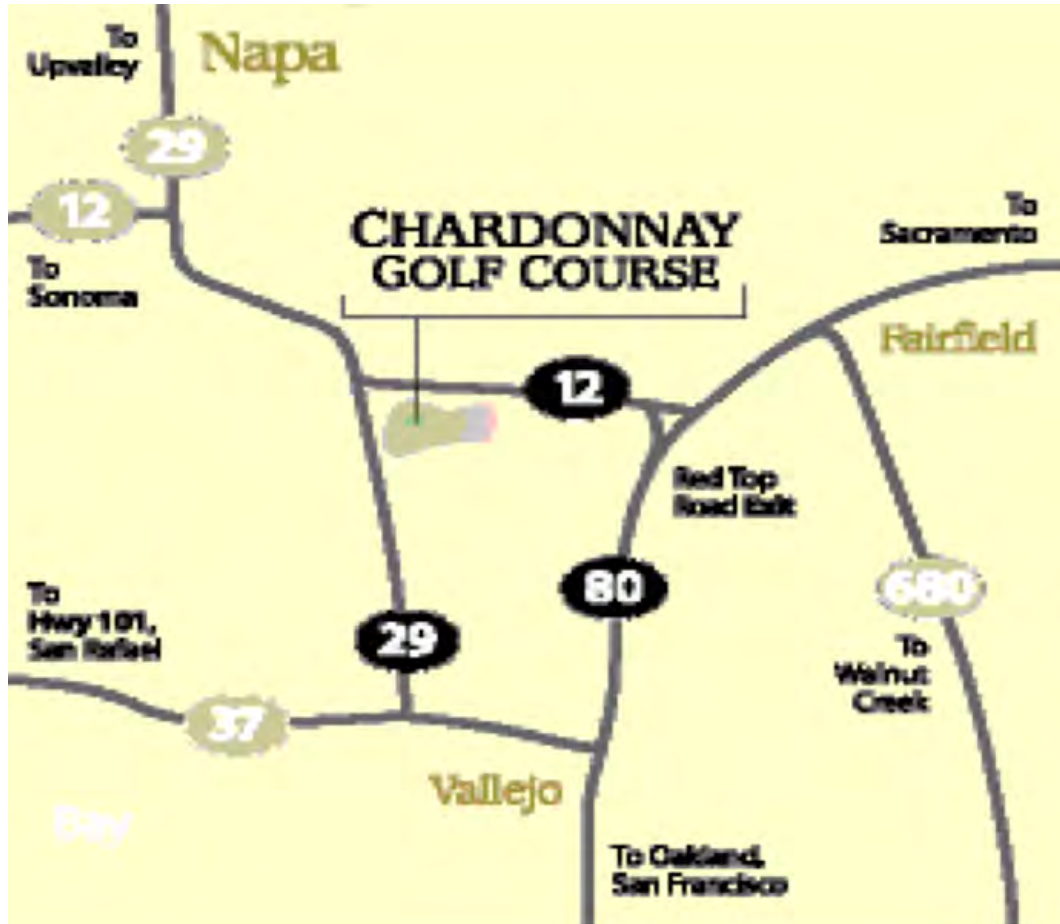
