# PILLAR ISPE KNOWLEDGE WITHOUT BORDERS

ISPE Knowledge without Borders enables a globally diverse workforce that can support the pharmaceutical industry both locally and internationally.

Through ISPE Knowledge without Borders, the ISPE Foundation seeks to remove barriers to entry for professionals across the globe, particularly in emerging economies. We empower professionals worldwide by providing access to educational resources, so they can investigate and develop treatments that are tailored to meet the conditions of their local communities.

### **Translations Program**

The ISPE Foundation Translations Program removes language barriers that hinder access to knowledge and training courses. ISPE Guidance Documents, the gold standard for technical knowledge in the industry for students, emerging leaders, regulators, and manufacturers in emerging economies, are made available in native languages.mational medicines to worldwide patient populations.

In 2023, we piloted the Technology without Borders Program in Brazil, making translated, culturally relevant, and locally adapted ISPE resources available in-country for the first time. As of June 2023, we achieved the following milestones:

### **ISPE Foundation Diversity Internship Program**

The pharmaceutical industry is experiencing an unprecedented pace and scale of disruption driven by new business models like personalized medicine and innovative product modalities such as cell and gene therapy. It also provides opportunities for women and other diverse groups to speak on pharmaceutical issues – this includes the delivery of technical presentations and contributions to panel discussions. A community of Women in Pharma mentors, resources across all levels, and educational sessions help enable career success and work-life balance.

A Women in Pharma Scholarship was awarded in 2023. ISPE's Women in Pharma Scholarship is a dedicated initiative aimed at fostering diversity, equity, and inclusion within the pharmaceutical industry by supporting and empowering women pursuing education and careers in this dynamic field.
